


RANGER Client Guide

Notes: Remote PC users will only be able to connect if the machine is powered on. Ranger will attempt to wake the machine if offline but to be safe please always leave your machine on if you want to connect remotely.

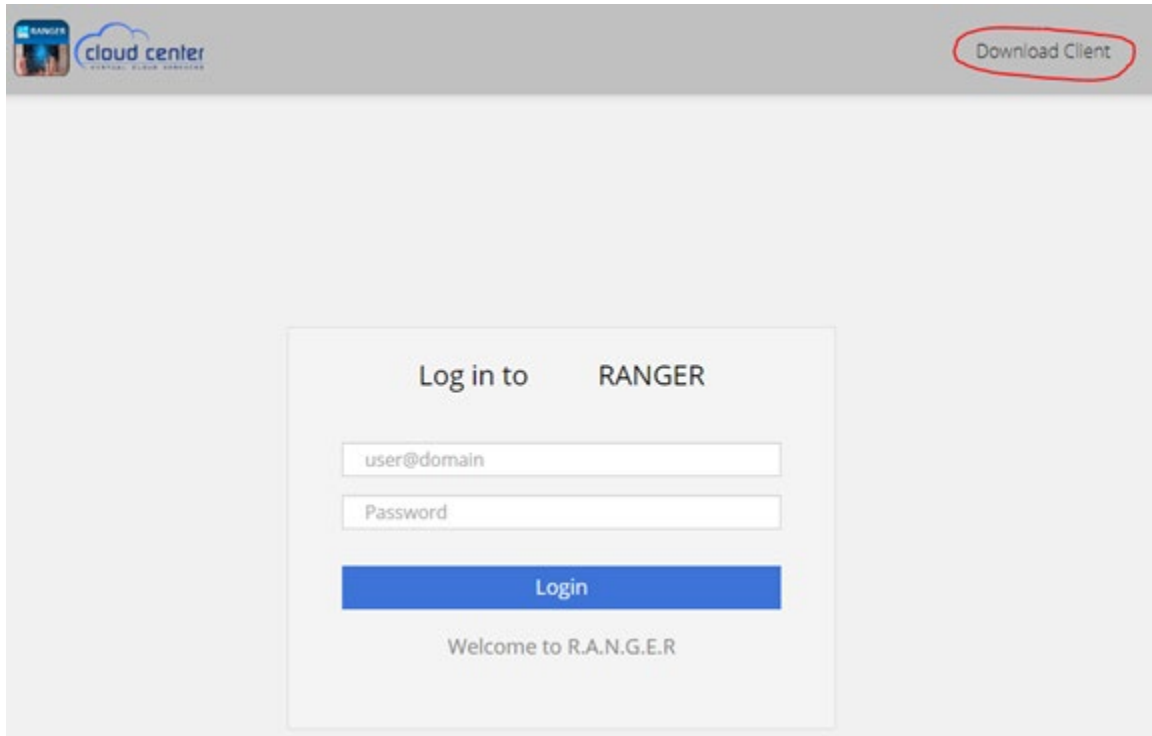




Step 4: Configure the client connection.


